Hours Available: 10 hours per week

In-person – Red Lake

No previous experience is required. Will be trained on the job.
Some gardening experience is preferred.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Maintain the Healing Garden by weeding, fertilizing, and controlling pests as needed.
- Harvest plants and deliver donations to Red Lake Nation programs as needed.
- Assist with Eco-festival by making posters about sustainable practices, Indigenous foods, and/or organic farming.
- Assist with the Grow Community youth project by helping K-12 youth harvest plants from the garden. Create recipe cards for youth to cook the foods they bring home.
- Help prepare the garden for next season and close it for winter.
- Must be comfortable lifting up to 40lbs, using garden tools (rake, loop hoe, trowel, etc.), and working outdoors.
- Other duties as assigned.
