The film is available to watch on Disney+.

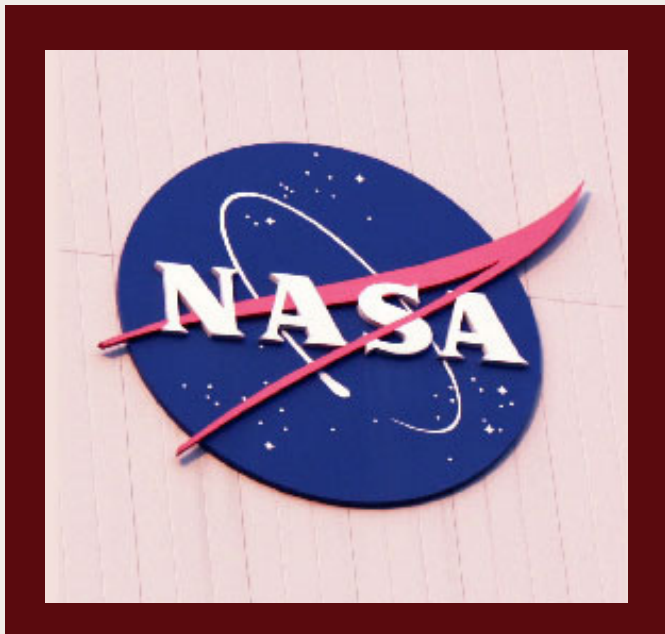


NASA/AIHEC TCU Building Bridges grant helps RLNC Internships!

At Red Lake Nation College (RLNC), the Natural Resources Research Internships program will collaborate with the Red Lake Department of Natural Resources to provide natural resources research internships for RLNC students. Students will work with Red Lake Department of Natural Resource staff on local projects in natural resource fields such as forestry, water resources, fisheries, and wildlife management. "The TCU Building Bridges Grant Program is a great example of how collaborating on common interests and goals can contribute to providing more opportunities in STEM. AIHEC and NASA will work together to support and facilitate TCU faculty and students engaging in research that addresses tribal and local priorities while encouraging students to pursue a career pathway in STEM," stated Keya T. Briscoe, Minority University Research and Education Project manager with NASA.

NASA MAIANSE and AIHEC are encouraged by TCU participation in this program and plans are underway for the next TCU Building Bridges Grant Program release in the fall of 2024.

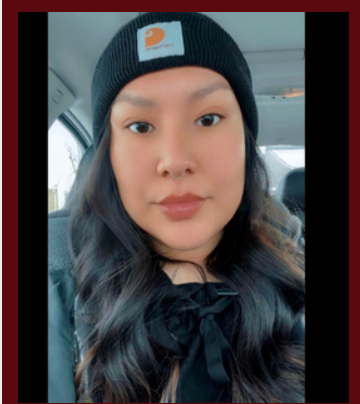

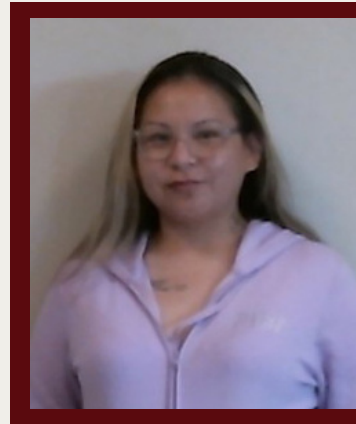
